

Opportunity to Serve
Preparing Quilts for tying.
(requires no sewing)

Cutting batting for quilt tops and pinning the three layers, preparing quilts for tying. (Batting is ordered by the Chairperson of Sewing Circle.)

The roll of batting is cut to quilt-top length. Usually, the whole roll is cut at one time.

The back that has been matched to a quilt top is placed on a table top. The batting placed on the back, and then the top is added and pinned in place. (The tops and backs are prepared for you.)

The three layers are pinned together with the minimum of pins to hold the layers in place. The quilt is then folded and stored in the sewing room ready to be tied.

The two women working this department will work with you throughout the remainder of this year--as needed--and help you get acquainted. We will meet the 2nd and 4th Thursdays, at 9 a.m. or at your convenience.
