

Opportunity to Serve
Quality Control of Sewing Circle Quilts

The purpose of this operation is to check for straight pins that have been left in quilts, to check for seams that sewing has missed, keep check on machine stitching to catch looping, etc.

Quilts are then boxed, taped, and labeled for Lutheran World Relief. Completely ready for the October delivery date to La Crosse. (The loading and delivery is not the responsibility of Quality Control.) Project Christmas quilts are bagged and stored in boxes until December. The number of completed quilts is kept on a tally sheet.

Supplies needed to accomplish Quality Control:

- Boxes are from Wood Sales and Service. We are most appreciative of this supply. The largest box from the rental service is charged out to Vicki's account. Usually only 4 boxes at a time are picked up so as not to deplete their supply. Seven quilts fit in one box, these are for LWR only; the Project Christmas boxes are picked up at Walmart in the Meat Dept.
- Packing tape is bought from any store and usually paid for from our Sunshine fund--or a bill can be turned in to the Women's treasurer.
- Labels with the church's name are printed in the church office.

In order to keep some semblance of order in the Sewing Room, Quality Control should be done (day or evening) after a Thursday of tying and before the next Thursday meeting.

The two women working this department will work with you throughout the remainder of this year--as needed--and help you get acquainted. We will meet the 2nd and 4th Thursdays, at 9 a.m. or at your convenience.
